## The Role

The successful candidates will lead the everyday running and maintenance of the school to ensure that our students and staff can learn and work in an environment that is safe, secure, and well presented. We welcome applications from candidates who have relevant experience of working in a maintenance and health and safety environment and who have good literacy and numeracy skills with the ability to successfully lead and manage a small team of staff.

The post holder will be responsible for the maintenance and security of the buildings and grounds, ensuring the cleanliness of the site as a welcoming, safe, and secure environment for students, staff and visitors, and will take responsibility for the ensuring full compliance with current health and safety legislations, as well as leading and managing the Site Supervisor. The post holder will be responsible for performing varied maintenance tasks or project work including minor repairs, decorating and improvement works. You will be responsible for providing a comprehensive service for building and grounds maintenance, cleaning and health and safety across the site.

The Site Team also provides an important out of hours service to both internal and external users and events, ranging from parents' evenings to hiring of the facilities for functions.

The candidate will need to be flexible, efficient and able to support the effective running of the site. A Driving license would be advantageous, and the Site Manager may be called out of hours in case of an emergency.
